Celebrating Goodness: Hon'ble President Dr. Priti G. Adani's Birthday at Adani University

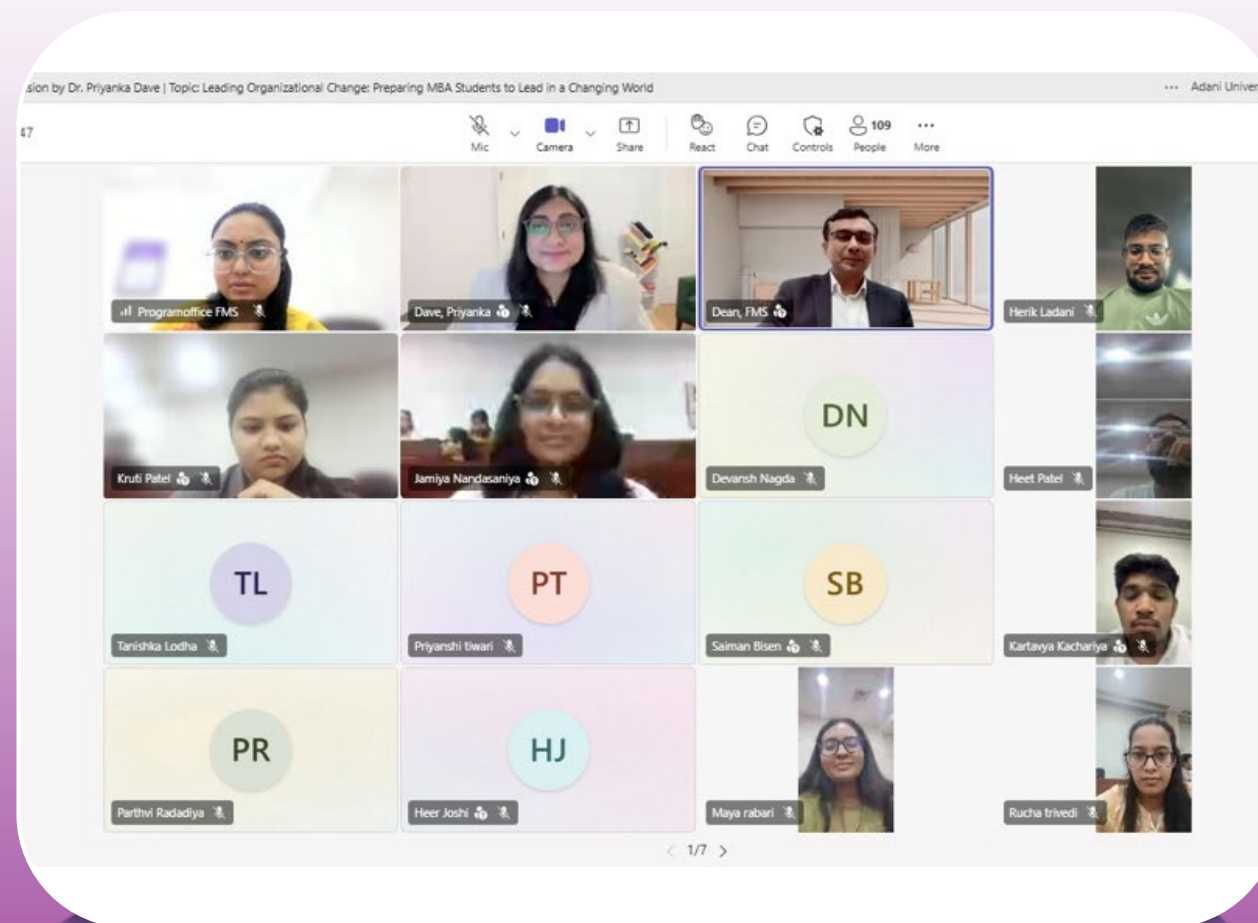

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From Research Ideas to Fundable Proposals

On September 5, 2026, the Department of Research and Doctoral Studies, Adani University, organised a session on "Recipe for Writing an Effective Research Proposal" as part of the Research Proposal Masterclass: From Concept to Funding. Led by Prof. (Dr.) Dhaval Pujara, Provost, the session offered faculty practical guidance on structuring compelling research proposals, covering abstracts, rationale, novelty, objectives, outcomes, deliverables, and activity planning. Prof. Pujara emphasised the importance of demonstrating significance, feasibility, impact, and alignment with funding priorities, equipping faculty to pursue external research funding with greater clarity and confidence.



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Beyond the Proposal: Thinking Like a Research Strategist

On September 5, 2026, the Department of Research and Doctoral Studies, Adani University, organised a session on “Strategies for Developing Potentially Successful Proposals” as part of the Research Proposal Masterclass: From Concept to Funding. Prof. (Dr.) Chinmay Ghorai, B.S. Gelot Chair Professor, IIT Gandhinagar, encouraged researchers to view proposals from a reviewer’s perspective, emphasising clarity, relevance, novelty, feasibility, and impact. He urged faculty to move beyond simply writing proposals and instead develop compelling, long-term research programmes with strong questions, meaningful outcomes, and clear value for funding agencies.

On September 5, 2026, Code Connect brought together first- and second-year students in a vibrant student-led event organised under the University Cultural Club, Rangved.
