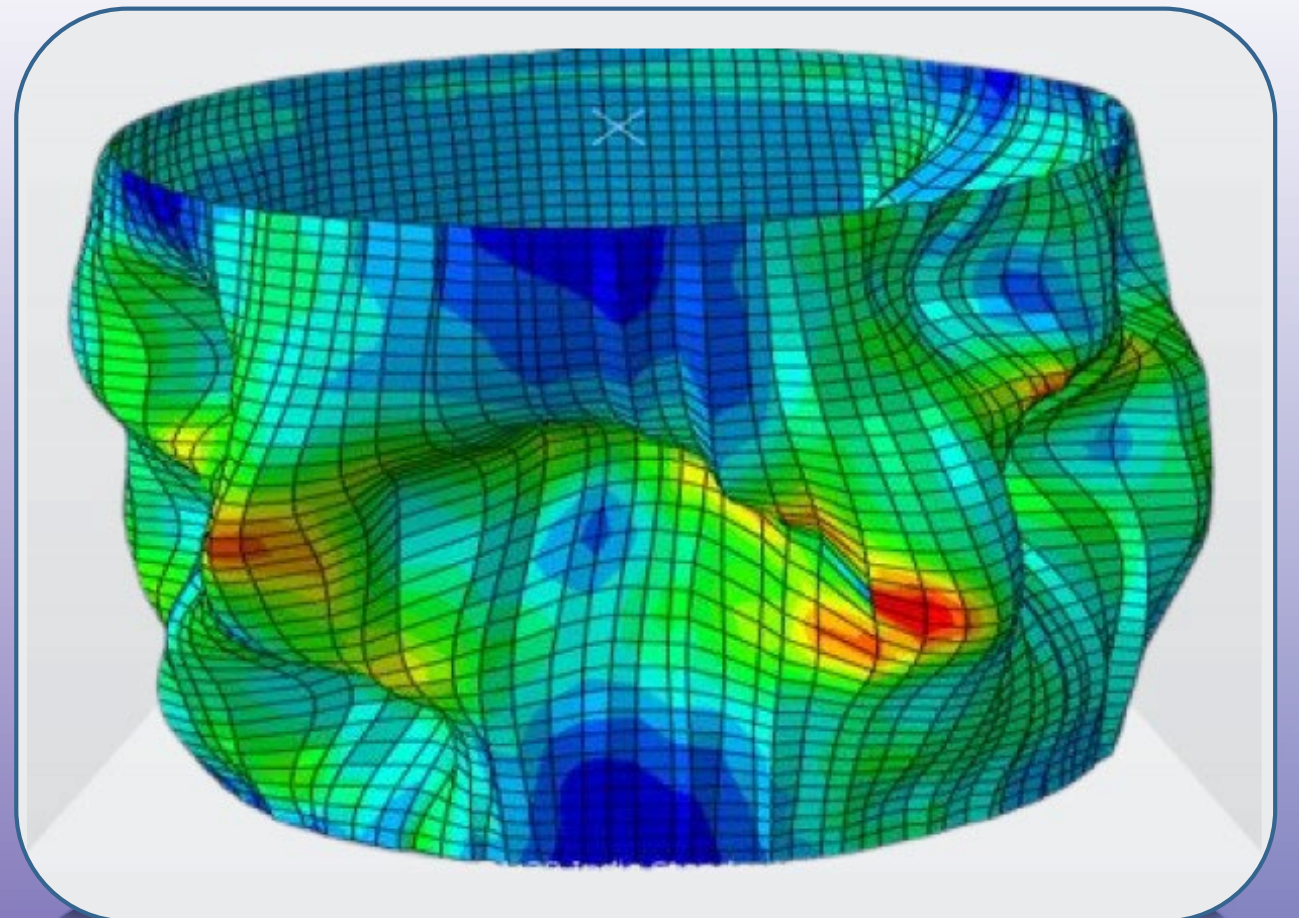
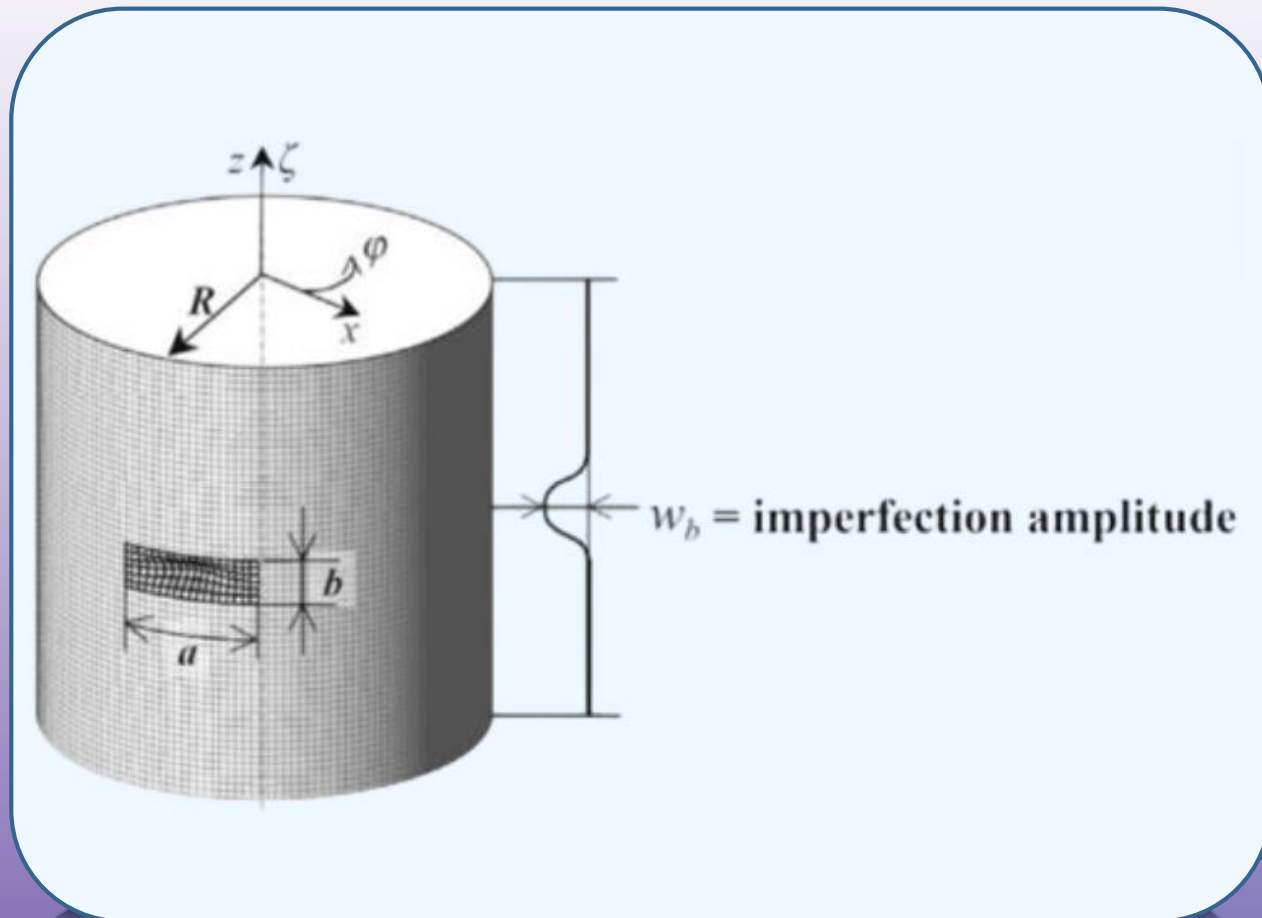

Book Chapter Publication in Springer Edited Book Series

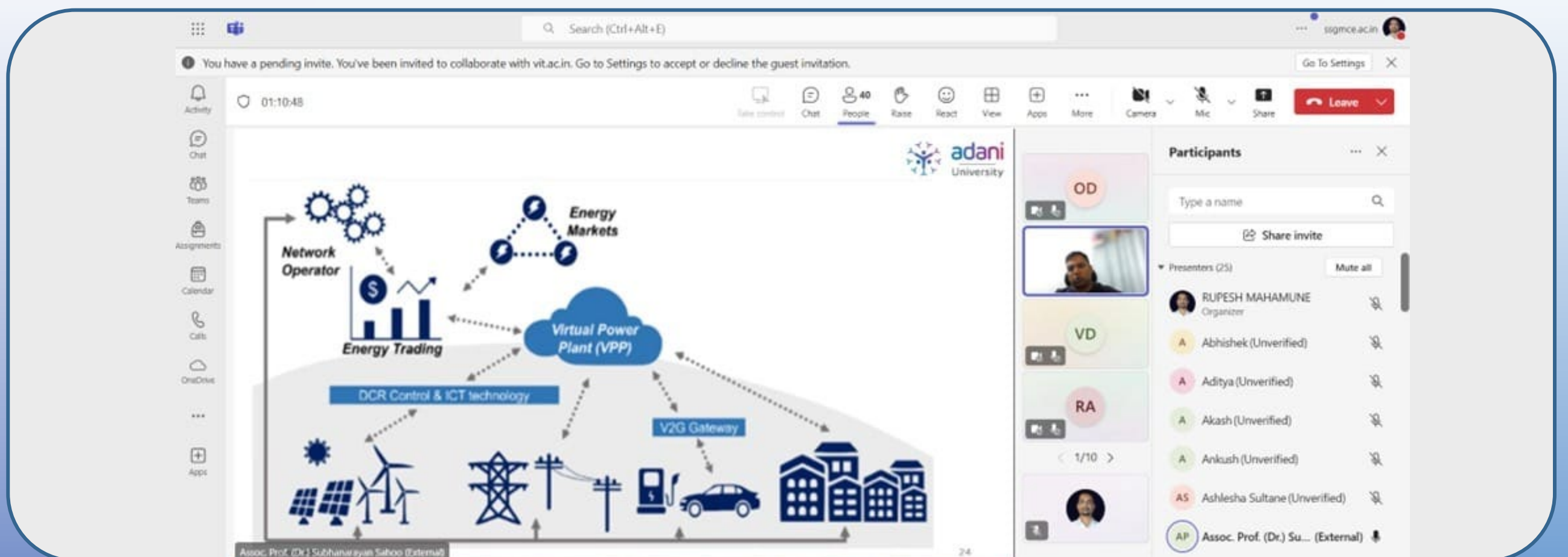
