Marketing Mavericks Launches a Story of Discipline and Belief

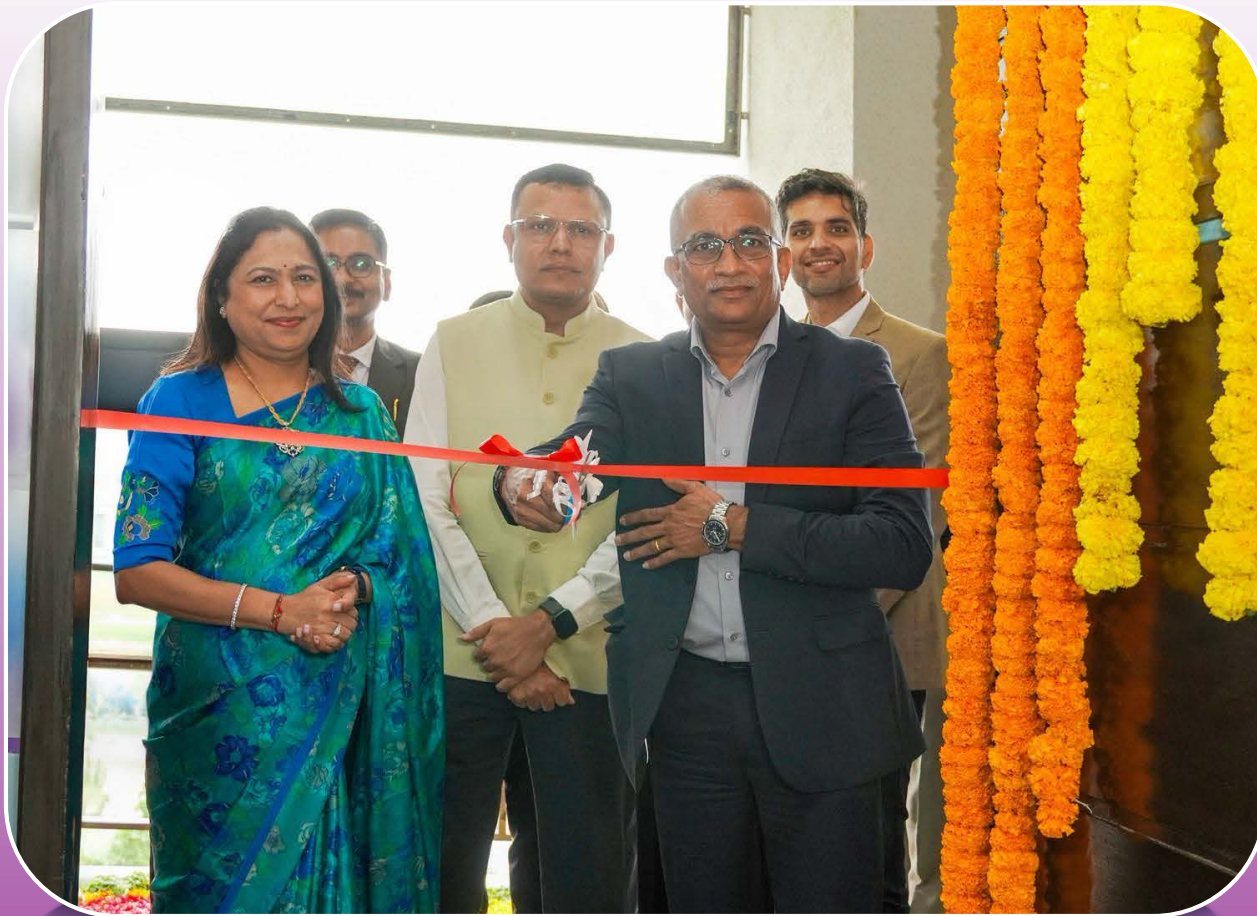

Adani University Inaugurates Arduino Edge AI Lab Powered by Qualcomm

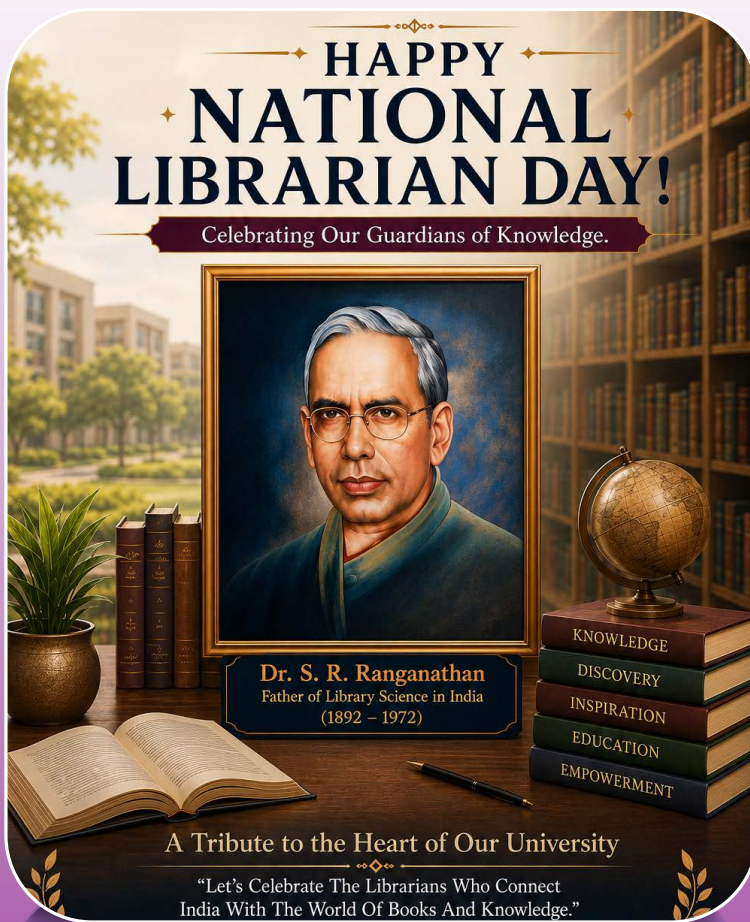
