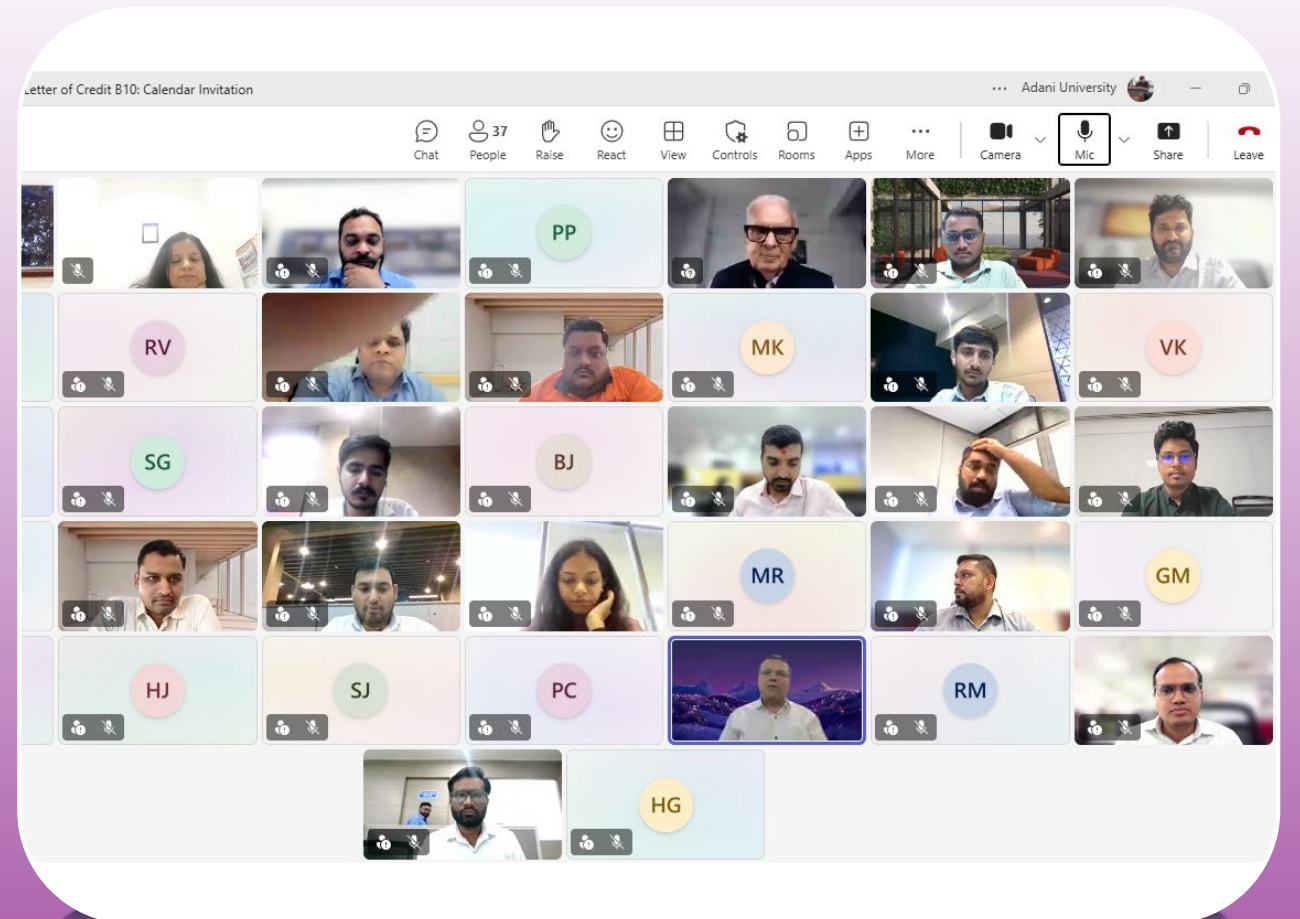
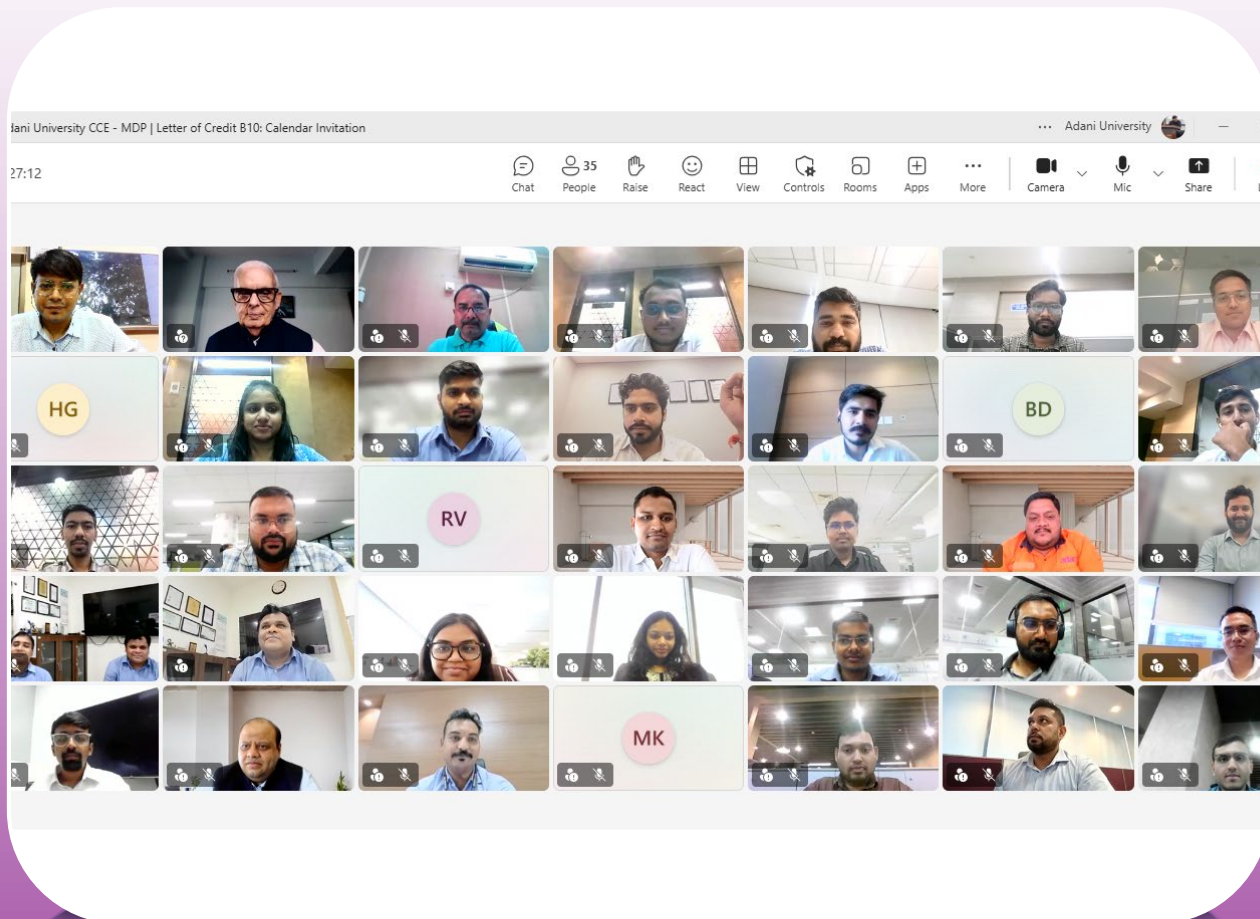




September 19, 2026
