Students Present Air Pollution Research at NEC-2026


During the 5th National Environmental Conference (NEC-2026) held on March 13–14, 2026, at the Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, four B.Tech. Semester VI students from the Department of Civil and Infrastructure Engineering, FEST, participated under the mentorship of Dr. Aman Deep Gupta. They presented research on the impact of air pollutants on short-term mortality in Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar using CPCB data (2019–2025). The conference brought together experts from academia and industry, offering a platform for knowledge exchange, networking, and discussions on key environmental challenges.




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Expert Session on

AirOwl Workshop by Oizom to Promote Air Quality Awareness and Hands-On Learning

On 20 March 2026, Faculty of Sciences, Adani University, in collaboration with Oizom Instruments Pvt. Ltd. conducted an interactive workshop on air quality awareness and monitoring technologies. The session introduced students to the causes and impacts of air pollution, explained the Air Quality Index (AQI), and addressed common misconceptions.
