


Joules Club Hosts "Wattage Wars" Moot Court Competition




Students Participation in Cyber Rakshak Natya Utsav

A research article of Ms. Devshri Oza (Teaching Assistant-CSE-FEST) titled "DeepFusionSent: A Novel Feature Fusion. Approach for Deep Learning-Enhanced Sentiment Classification" has been accepted for publication in Information Fusion (Q1 Journal). This study is a part of her PhD research work introduces DeepFusionSent, a novel feature fusion framework for sentiment classification that captures linguistic patterns beyond raw features. It incorporates positive-negative word distance metrics to enhance classification performance. The approach is evaluated against Machine Learning, Deep Learning, and transformer-based models, demonstrating superior improvements with statistically significant analysis.
