MBA students of the Real Estate Economics and Policy course visited Shantigram Township, gaining insights into sustainable urban living. They explored key infrastructure, including the Water Treatment Plant, which ensures clean potable water from the Narmada canal, and the Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP), which recycles wastewater for landscaping and non-potable uses under a Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) system. The township's waste management converts kitchen waste into compost and handles dry waste sustainably. Additionally, the advanced security system ensures round-the-clock safety. The visit provided students with valuable practical knowledge of township infrastructure management.
