Guidelines for extended abstract: (minimum 1500 words)

1. The extended abstract must contain the following sections: Introduction, Methodology, Findings, Conclusion, and References. Sections can be named differently, and subsections may be included.
2. The extended abstract must be submitted as a Microsoft Word document. All images (illustrations, charts, photos) must be placed in the text just after the first point of reference.
3. Tables must be created using the Microsoft Word table functions and included as part of the text immediately after the first point of reference. Do not place them at the end of your extended abstract.
4. Use APA 7th Edition as citation style
